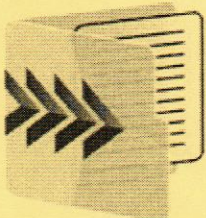



Pursuant to the implementation of the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) to prevent the spread of coronavirus disease 2019, offices are closed and the processing of travel documents of the children are on hold. In bound and outboudna travels have been restricted, hence families who were supposedly travelling to fetch their prospective adoptive children were on hold.

However, due to uncontrollable factors such as PAPs inability to handle the demands of the behavior of a child or the child's high expectation of the adoption placement, the placement does not lead to finalization of the adoption. ICAB collaborative work with FAA and CA to find suitable replacement family and afforded therapy to minimize the trauma of disruption.</p>
