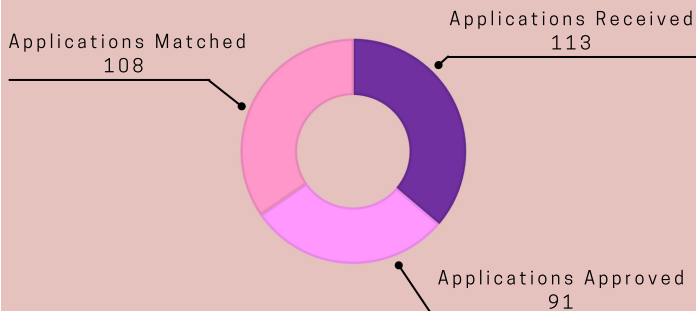

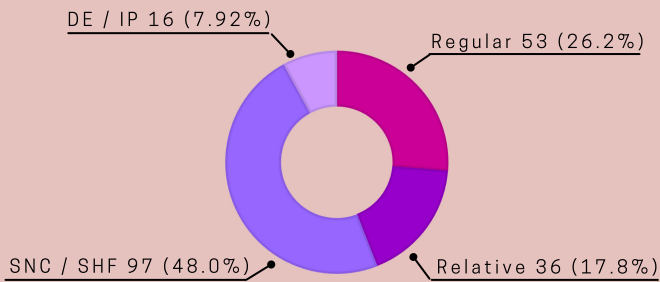
ADOPTION APPLICATIONS



For the year 2020, ICAB received 113 adoption applications of prospective adoptive parents (PAPs), 91 of which were approved in 2020.

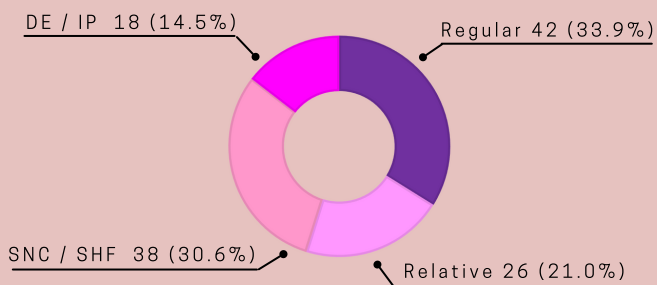
During the year, 108 PAPs were matched with a child/ren.

CHILDREN REFERRED



- There were a total of 202 children referred for intercountry adoption by the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD).
- Fifty-three (53) children for regular program, sixteen (16) children for the category of direct entrustment / independent placement, ninety-seven (97) children for special home finding (SHF) and thirty-six (36) children for relative adoption.

CHILDREN MATCHED



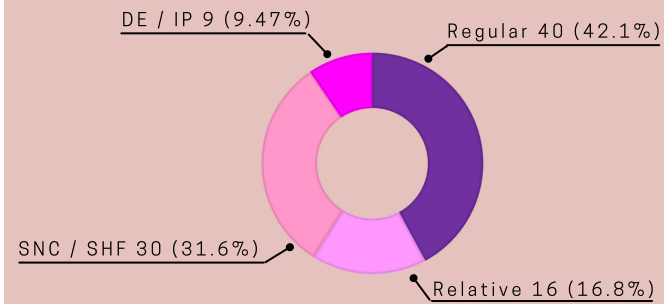
Forty-two (42) children were matched in the regular program, twenty-six (26) children matched in the relative program, thirty-eight (38) children in special home finding program, and eighteen were direct-entrustment / independent placement cases.

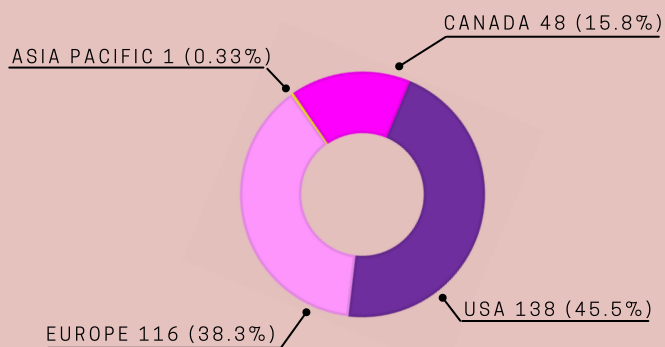

CHILDREN ENTRUSTED



The Global Pandemic affected the number of actual entrustments of children to prospective adoptive parents. Of the 106 children matched for intercountry adoption, ninety-five (95) were entrusted to their PAPS.

CHILDREN UNDER SUPERVISION



Children placed for intercountry adoption are monitored through the endorsement of bi-monthly or as prescribed post-placement reports by the Foreign Adoption Agencies / Central Authorities.

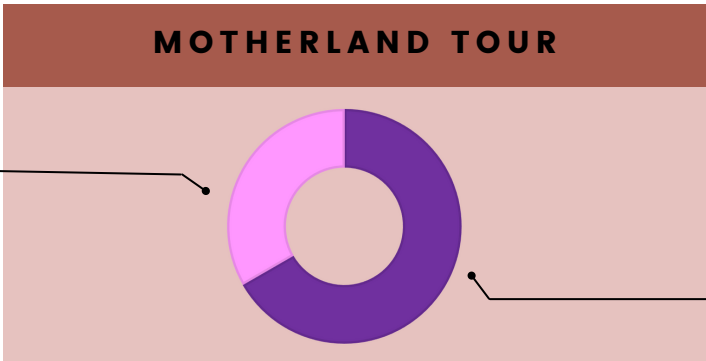

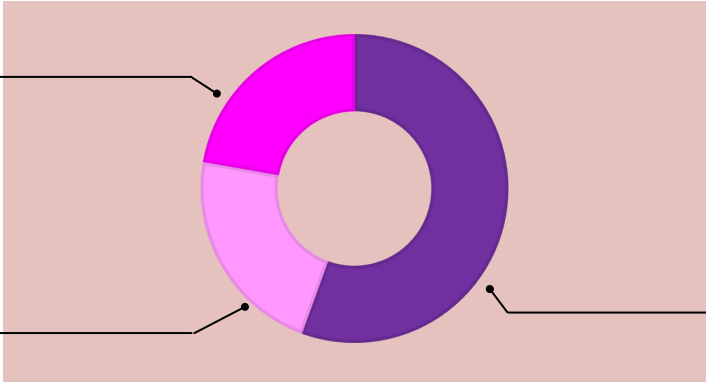

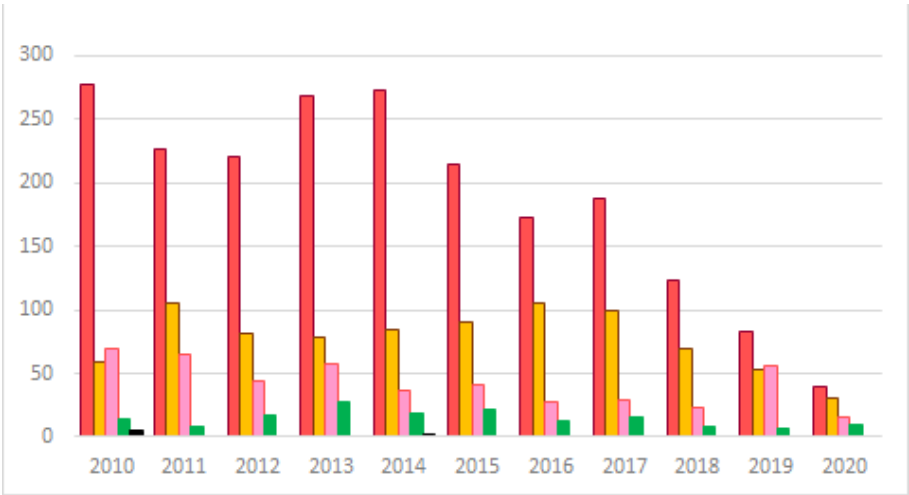
ICAB envisions that all adoption placements are successful and will have no disruption. However, due to uncontrollable factors attributed to PAPs and child/ren, the placement does not lead to finalization of the adoption.

For 2020, a total of nine (9) children placements were disrupted. Five (5) children under the special home finding program; two (2) children under the relative program and two (2) independent placement / direct entrustment cases.

ADOPTION PLACEMENTS BASED ON DEMOGRAPHICS

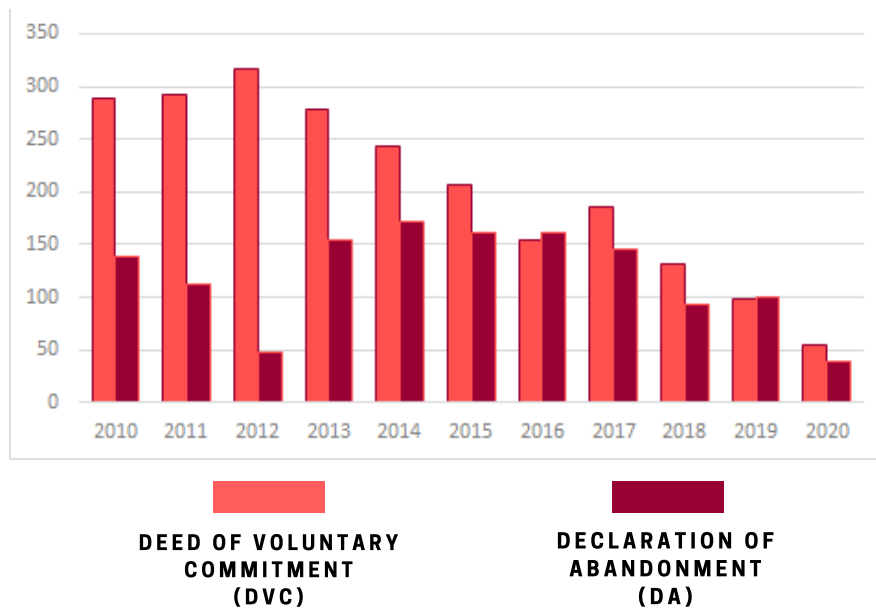
